Q: WHERE WILL CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022 TAKE PLACE?

A: Canadian Leadership Training 2022 will take place at the Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel in Banff, Alberta.

Q: WHAT ARE THE EVENT DATES FOR CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022?

A: Canadian Leadership Training 2022 will take place December 12-14, 2022.

Q: WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO EARN CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022?

A: Only Market Partners in Canada are eligible to earn Canadian Leadership Training 2022.

Q: WHAT IS THE QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022?

A: June 1, 2022, through November 30, 2022, at 11:59 p.m. Eastern.

Q: HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022?

A: A Canadian Market Partner can earn their way to Canadian Leadership Training 2022 by completing at least one of the following qualifications:

Rank advance to AED, ED, or SED between December 1, 2021, and November 30, 2022, and you automatically earn your trip. All MMM's must be paid as their career Rank for 1 out of 6 months and build 1 block cumulatively during the qualification period. For MMMs who have lost their Career Rank, re-rank to Career Rank MMM and build 1 block cumulatively during the qualification period.	All MM's must be paid as their Career Rank for 1 out of 6 months and build 1 block cumulatively during the qualification period. For MMs who have lost their Career Rank, re-rank to Career Rank MM and build 1 block cumulatively during the qualification period.

Q: WHAT IS INCLUDED IN CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022?

A: Canadian Leadership Training 2022 includes round trip Economy Airfare (where applicable) for one Market Partner (MM-SED) and two-night hotel accommodation for the training dates. All ground transportation, meals and excursions planned by MONAT will also be covered.

Q: I AM LOCAL TO THE EVENT LOCATION, WILL TRANSPORTATION BE PROVIDED FOR ME?

A: Transportation to/from Canadian Leadership Training 2022 is not included if you are local to the event destination. Local is considered within 4 hours driving time.

Q: WHAT ARE THE 'RULES' AROUND CHANGING FLIGHTS AND GROUND TRANSPORTATION?

A: If you must change a confirmed flight by Corporate Traveller, you will be personally responsible for change fees. If ground transportation has been arranged for you, and you choose not to use it within 48 hours of the planned pick up, you will be charged the per person cost of that ride.

Q: CAN I BRING A SPOUSE/GUEST TO CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022?

A: Yes. You may bring a non-Market Partner spouse/guest over the age of 18 at a fee of \$1000 CAD. Round trip airfare is at the expense of the guest.

Q: CAN I TAKE A CASH REWARD INSTEAD OF ATTENDING CANADIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING 2022?

A: No. We will not be substituting a cash reward for the event.

Q: WHAT IF I AM UNABLE TO MAKE IT, DO I STILL GET THE FREE HOTEL ACCOMMODATION AT SOME OTHER TIME?

A: No. The hotel accommodation must be used for the training dates.

Q: WILL MONAT PAY FOR MY EXTENDED STAY?

A: No. MONAT will only cover the costs for the nights of the earned training dates as outlined above. Exceptions will not be made for shared rooms.

Q: WHAT HAPPENS IF THE EVENT CANNOT TAKE PLACE DUE TO COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS OR ANY OTHER UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES?

A: Canadian Leadership Training 2022 is not an incentive trip, it is a training for our Leaders (MM-SED). If for reasons out of our control we can not hold the event on the date communicated, we will do our best to postpone the event or hold it in another format (i.e. virtually). There is no monetary compensation for a training event.

Q: DO I NEED TO BE COVID-19 VACCINATED TO ATTEND?

A: All provincial health restrictions and guidelines are in effect and must be followed. Please check local and provincial COVID-19 regulations prior to travel to ensure you are meeting the necessary requirements. MONAT is NOT responsible for setting the guidelines.
